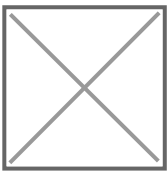


## A THANK YOU FROM A CLIENT AFTER A SUCCESSFUL THREE WEEK JURY TRIAL IN FEDERAL COURT

Gold Eagle asserted that this claim, and many other claims made by Star Tron were false in violation of the Lanham Act. After reviewing reams of scientific and other support for Star Tron's claims, the jury rendered a verdict that Star Brite did not engage in false advertising.
