In addition to defending healthcare fraud, bank fraud, drug conspiracy, and weapons exportation cases, Ravindran represented a former CEO of a concert promotion company in a \$300 million Ponzi scheme, conducted a two-week jury trial in a tax preparation fraud case, and litigated sixteen cases before the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals, including two oral arguments.

In 2013, Ravindran served as a law clerk to United States District Judge Patricia A. Seitz. Prior to his clerkship, Ravindran was a Captain in the United States Marine Corps and served as a Judge Advocate. During his military tenure, he was awarded the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal.

Ravindran completed his B.A. and J.D. at Emory University where he served as the Managing Editor on the *Emory Bankruptcy Developments Journal*. He also has a master's degree in Comparative Politics from the London School of Economics and Political Science
