Christopher Andrew Jarvinen, a partner on the Business Reorganization Team of Berger Singerman LLP, served as a judge at the prestigious Mediation Tournament 2022. He has also studied in graduate programs at Teachers College of Columbia University, the Judge Business School of the University of Cambridge and Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health. For three years, Mr. Jarvinen taught International Legal Management to graduate business students at FGV-EAESP.
